MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION AND REQUIREMENTS

The U.S. Hemp Roundtable, Inc. (hereinafter also referred to as "Organization") was established to educate, advocate and secure passage of policies or laws that will benefit the hemp industry and remove it from the purview of the Controlled Substance Act. All members agree to advocate and promote issues that are only in the best interest of the hemp industry. By submitting this application, all applicants and members agree to contribute to and to maintain the positive reputation of the U.S. Hemp Roundtable, Inc. by doing the following:

- Always conduct themselves in a professional manner when representing the organization.
- To avoid any activity or discussion of any issues that would present a conflict of interest with the organization. Specifically, members must avoid any advocacy on behalf of the legalization of marijuana or other controlled substances when representing the organization. Of course, you may exercise your First Amendment rights, and/or be involved in non-hemp business activities on your own time, when not representing the Roundtable.
- To hold yourself and your firm to the highest standard for the industry. Specifically, members who sell hemp-derived products to the public should obey all laws, and never make disease remediation claims unless authorized by law or regulation.
- To report any conflict of interest to the Board of Directors whenever it occurs.
- To refrain from defaming other members of the organization.

Participation on a director level and membership in the U.S. Hemp Roundtable, Inc. is contingent on meeting membership criteria, compliance with all requirements included in this document and approval by the Board of Directors of the U.S. Hemp Roundtable, Inc. Membership in the U.S. Hemp Roundtable, Inc. may be revoked at any time for any reason. If membership is revoked, dues will be refunded, pro-rated to the length of time spent as a member. Please note that these guidelines and benefits are subject to change.

Rights and Privileges of Membership. A Member who has been admitted and who has paid membership dues for the current Program Year has the following rights and privileges for that Program Year:

- **If Membership is on the Board of Directors Level** this level requires an annual contribution of \$30,000. This membership level provides for participation in the governance of the organization and includes voting rights in addition to the general member benefits that are outlined in this section.
- If Membership is on the Member Level this level requires an annual contribution of \$10,000. This membership level includes voting rights and access to perks such as the 50 State Hemp and CBD

Law Survey in addition to the general member benefits that are outlined in this section in addition to the general member benefits that are outlined in this section.

If Membership is on the Advocacy Partner Level – this level requires an annual contribution of \$1,000 and approval by a board committee to qualify. This membership level includes all general member benefits that are outlined below:

General Member benefits include the ability:

- To attend each continuing education program, dinner meeting, and other event presented, hosted, or co-sponsored by the Organization during the current Program Year;
- To attend and bring one or more guests to any program event, subject to the Member's payment of a per-guest meal charge set by the Board of Directors; and
- To have the Member's name, address, and other contact information listed in the Organization's Membership Directory and on any website maintained by the Organization.
